Houston soprano **Nancy Curtis** enjoys a multifaceted career as a singer of opera, oratorio, symphonic repertoire, and recitals. Nancy's commitment to her artistry has drawn praise from colleagues, audiences, and critics alike, and she is in demand as a vocalist and teacher. An honors graduate from **Baylor University**, Ms. Curtis has studied at the **Verdi Conservatory** in Milan, Italy, the **Dante Alghieri School** in Florence, Italy and the **Goethe Institute** in Rothenburg, Germany.

Hailed as a "stand-out", Ms. Curtis has been presented as the soprano soloist with many outstanding symphony orchestras including the Austin Symphony (Mahler #4 and Barber's Knoxville: Summer of 1915), the Maryland Symphony (Mahler #4 and Mozart's Exultate Jubilate), the Virginia Symphony (Handel's Messiah), the Arkansas Symphony (Messiah), the Santa Fe Symphony (Messiah), the San Antonio Symphony (La Traviata and Magic Flute), the Tulsa Philharmonic and Ballet (Carmina Burana) as well as the Houston Masterworks Chorus (Vaughan Williams' Sea Symphony), the Victoria Bach Festival (Sea Symphony and Mendelssohn's Elijah), the Houston Choral Society (Mozart's Requiem), the Mercury Baroque Ensemble (Caldara's Christmas Cantata and Handel's Messiah), and the International Festival Institute at Round Top (Handel's Gloria).

This highly versatile singer also enjoys an active opera career. She has been featured with opera companies including the New York City Opera (Gretel in Hansel and Gretel), Houston Grand Opera (Miffie in The Achilles Heel and First Nursemaid in Street Scene), Virginia Opera (Amore in Orfeo ed Euridice), the Tulsa Opera (Pamina in the Magic Flute and Gretel in Hansel and Gretel), the Lyric Opera of San Antonio (Musetta in La Boheme), Skylight Opera Theatre (Lucia in Lucia di Lammermoor), the Tacoma Opera (Gilda in Rigoletto), the St. Cecilia Chamber Music Society (Sister Angelica in Suor Angelica), the American Festival for the Arts (Abigal Proctor in The Crucible under the direction of the composer, Robert Ward), Ars Lyrica (Belinda in Purcell's Dido and Aeneas), and the Monteux Opera Festival (Miss Wordsworth in Albert Herring and Laurie in The Tender Land).

As a winner of the prestigious **Enrico Caruso International Vocal Competition**, Ms. Curtis was invited to sing concerts in Italy including an appearance at **La Scala**. She has been invited to sing for many of our nation's leaders including former **Presidents George Bush**, **Bill Clinton**, **Ronald Reagan**, and **Texas Governor Rick Perry**. She has also had the privilege of singing our *National Anthem* for the **Houston Texans**, the **Houston Rockets**, and **Houston Comets** and was recently honored to sing for the national commissioning of the *USS Texas* featuring former **First Lady**, **Laura Bush**.

Nancy is also an active member of **Conspirare**, the **Grammy nominated** and **internationally acclaimed** choral group based in Austin, TX. **Conspirare** was recently featured in a TV special for PBS that was aired nationally.
